

Stitch out splitted designs

- 1) Send the 2 or 3 (or more) design files to your embroidery system.
- 2) Hoop a tear-away stabilizer in the hoop. Use "temporary adhesive" on it, and smooth the fabric to be embroidered in place in the hoop. Use pins, if you want.
- 3) Open and embroider the first design file, including the 2 marks.
- 4) Remove carefully the fabric from the hoop.
- 5) Remove the stabilizer, be careful "DO NOT remove the 2 marks".
- 6) Hoop a second piece of tear-away stabilizer. WITHOUT THE FABRIC ON IT.
- 7) Open the second design file and embroider the first color: the 2 marks
- 8) Spray "temporary adhesive" on the stabilizer.
- 9) Place 2 pins on the fabric, in the 2 marks of the first part of the design
- 10) Place these pins in the 2 marks you just sewn out on the stabilizer in the hoop.
- 11) Smooth the fabric and embroidered design onto the stabilizer in the hoop.
- 12) Complete the embroidery with the second design.
- 13) Repeat the process with a third part if necessary.
